Mission Statement

The purpose of the Friends of Calvert County Seniors, Inc. (FCCS) is to provide funds to qualified seniors of Calvert County for services which will improve their quality of life and assist them in remaining independent when governmental or grant funds are insufficient.

History

In the summer of 1992, the Calvert County Commission on Aging discussed the need for forming an organization to support the needs of the rapidly increasing senior population because many necessary services are not available through Medicare, medical assistance or other sources in the county. The Friends of Calvert County Seniors, Inc. (FCCS) was formed out of this need.

FCCS is a private, tax-exempt, charitable organization that was founded in January 1993. Its purpose is to provide financial assistance to the senior citizens (aged 60-plus) of Calvert County that are not otherwise available to them. This will improve their quality of life and/or would enable them to remain independent and self-supporting.

Services

Friends of Calvert County Seniors, Inc. (FCCS) can provide assistance and supplement existing programs for the elderly when governmental or grant funds are insufficient or unavailable.

Examples include, but are not limited to:

- hearing assistance
- cost of prescriptions on a short-term basis
- eye exams
- glasses
- short-term emergency home care
- prostheses for the physically handicapped
- specialized transportation for medical treatment purposes

Dental Program

- Seniors with limited income and resources have access to assistance for necessary dental care.
- Friends will cover up to \$2,000 in dental expenses. Seniors who receive services are asked to reimburse 10% of the total cost of dental expenses.
